What are the requirements for studying at a German university?

- Recognised **higher education entrance qualification** (Hochschulzugangsberechtigung; HZB)
Does your diploma qualify you to study in Germany?

- **German at Level C1**

Don't speak and understand German well enough?

Once a year as part of its academic integration initiative, Magdeburg-Stendal University of Applied Sciences offers the following courses (both in Magdeburg and in Stendal):

- **Language courses in preparation for studying** - "German as a Foreign Language" - target level C1
(12 months, every day Monday to Friday)
- **Integration Assistance**
(late summer school, buddy programme, RONDO, guest student programme among others)
- **Advice** on all of the steps you will need to take
(e.g. application, commencing studies, financing possibilities)

What are the requirements for taking part in the initiative?

- Recognised **refugee status** (residency permit / prospect of remaining in the country)
- Recognised **higher education entrance qualification** (including in the event of incomplete / missing proof of qualifications or certificates)
- Successful completion of integration course / proof of **German language skills to level B1**
- Specific **programme preference**

What do you need for your application?

- Complete **application form** (see here: www.hs-magdeburg.de/studium-fuer-gefluechtete)
- Sign application form
- Write a **curriculum vitae** (no gaps)
- Include copies of all available certificates / proofs
 - ✓ **Residence Permit**
 - ✓ Certificate of participation / certificate from an integration course (where required) or other level **B1 German certificate**
 - ✓ **Proof of qualifications** (translated into German or English):
 - high school diploma
 - or degree certificate where applicable
 - overview of grades and subjects
 - proof of completed school years / years at university
 - ✓ Where available: official letter of recognition of your proof of qualifications (e.g. from the state education authority for Saxony-Anhalt)

What should you do with your application?

Was your certificate lost when you fled?

Magdeburg-Stendal University of Applied Sciences offers the possibility of having your aptitude for study tested (TestAS / specialist examinations). If successful, you may study without full proof of qualifications.



What is the timetable for our initiative in 2017?

15 June	Deadline for applications
June / July:	a) Complete documents: recognition of qualifications where applicable b) Incomplete documents: TestAS (test for foreign students)
August:	feedback on your application
18 - 30 September:	Start of participation: late summer school (preparation for studying)
02 October 2017 to 28 September 2018:	12-month intensive language course: "German as a Foreign Language"
From June:	TestDaF examinations

When can you begin your degree course?

If you **successfully** complete the language course (TestDaF 4x TDN4), you may apply for a place on a degree course anywhere in the country. Exact details of how to apply and any deadlines you need to meet may differ depending on the university and course. Ideally you will be able to apply from May 2018 and commence your studies in the 2018/19 winter semester.
