Chancen-Aufenthaltsrecht (§104c)

with lawyer Thomas Stöckl (specialized in migration law)

Content: Since December 31, 2022, refugees and asylum seekers who are currently 'tolerated' (geduldet) are, under certain conditions, able to apply for the so-called "right of residence opportunity" in order to obtain a secure residence status.

The **CAST project** of the Refugee Council in Saxony-Anhalt (**Flüchtlingsrat Sachsen-Anhalt**) aims to help them find ways to secure their right to stay and to accompany them through the application process and beyond.

Target group: The workshop is intended exclusively for people with tolerated status (**Duldung**). Participants can ask legal and organizational questions about their prospects and options for staying in Germany and receive free advice in a safe, anonymous space.

Advice can be given in French, English, German and Russian. Your children can also be looked after on site.

Additional Information: Thomas Stöckl, lawyer for migration law, will present information on long-term prospects for staying in Germany through the "Chancen-Aufenthalt" program and will be available to answer specific questions.

CAST project staff Stefanie Lübcke, Michael Bertram and Julius Scholz will also be present.

Registration/travel costs: There is no participation fee. Travel costs for tolerated persons from Saxony-Anhalt can be covered by the Refugee Council.
